YEAR 7 SWIM SCHOOL

Next week Year 7 will attend Swim School for two days at Manly Swim Centre, followed by a beach day on the following Monday. This is a compulsory component of the Aquatics section of the PDHPE syllabus. This year the PDHPE Department have managed to secure two grants and the school has contributed some of the funds brought in through hiring out the school gym to the Swim School budget. This has enabled the school to subsidise half of the cost of Swim School this year, bringing the total cost of Swim School down from \$120 to \$60. Unfortunately, rising bus costs have contributed to increasing prices for activities like this. We look forward to reports of learning and fun from the water's side from Year 7.
