- One week at Space Camp Huntsville, Alabama where the students trained as basic astronauts, designed and built rockets, completed weightlessness training, defeated obstacle courses and flew on simulated missions to space
- Three days in Washington D.C. where we visited several of the famous Smithsonian museums, had a guided tour of the Senate building (with way too much marble) and a night bus tour of the highlights the city has to offer
- Three days in Orlando, Florida here we didn't stop with indoor skydiving, shopping, airboats on the everglades, visit to Kennedy Space Centre to have lunch with an astronaut and a full day at Universal Studios
